ORDER

Provisional affiliation was granted to start College of Applied Science, Vadakkencherry, Palakkad under IHRD in 1993-94 with B.Sc Computer Science(24) and B.Sc Electronics (24) programmes, vide University Order read as (1). Later the intake of B.Sc Electronics (24) and B.Sc Computer Science (24) was increased to 34 and 36 respectively. Additional affiliation was granted to M.Sc Computer Science (12) in 2002-03, M.Sc Electronics (12) in 2003-04 and B.Com Computer Application (40) in 2009-10, vide University Orders read as (2), (3) and (4) respectively.

2. Additional affiliation was granted to B.Com Finance (40) in 2017-18, vide University Orders read as (5) and (7). Permanent increase in seats was granted to B.Sc Electronics, from 34 to 36, w.e.f 2017-18, vide University Order read as (6).

3. Regulations for Calicut University Four Year Undergraduate Programme (CUFYUGP Regulations 2024) for affiliated colleges from the academic year 2024-25 has been implemented vide University Order read as (8). Continuation of provisional affiliation was granted to the aforementioned programmes for the academic year 2024-25, vide University Order read as (9).

4. The Principal, vide paper read as (10) has applied for continuation of provisional affiliation to the programmes for the academic year 2025-26.

5. Considering the above, the Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction for granting continuation of provisional affiliation, for 2025-26, to the programmes as detailed below with strict direction to engage faculties with qualifications prescribed by the respective regulatory body and in compliance with the provisions of the ACT 13 of 2021.

6. Orders are issued accordingly subject to the following terms and conditions :

- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2025-26. The colleges must apply for CPA for the ensuing years by remitting the fee fixed by the University from time to time, along with the extension of approval orders, if any, from the apex bodies concerned.
- The Principal shall follow the syllabi available on the University website (www.uoc.ac.in)/ approved by the University for selecting courses.
- To offer a Double Major pathway, sufficient workload should be available.
- To offer a new Double Major programme, the college should apply under "New Courses" as per the existing regulations.
- All affiliated colleges must comply with all the conditions of CUFYUGP regulations.
- Minor courses can also be offered by the departments offering Common Courses in English/Second Language or Complementary Courses in the existing UG Programmes, irrespective of whether they offer Major Courses, ensuring that there is sufficient workload/work arrangements for the same.
- The courses in this order shall not be treated as a factor for calculating the workload for the subject or the requirement of teaching faculty, for which competent orders shall be obtained from the Government/ University.
- Selection and admission shall be made only on the basis of the rules and regulations of the University/Government and based on the directions issued by the University/ Government from time to time.
- In the light of the directions of the Supreme Court of India in WP (C) 656/1998, the institution shall take stringent measures for the prevention of ragging in any form. In case of failure to prevent such instances of ragging, appropriate action, including withdrawal of affiliation of the college, will be initiated.
- The conduct of examinations is not permitted in colleges unless they have been granted the continuation of provisional affiliation or their application is under process.
- The conduct of University Examinations, including SDE Examinations, is compulsory and binding on all colleges affiliated with the University of Calicut.
- Admission to the next academic year shall be made only after obtaining prior permission from the University.
- No students shall be admitted to any course of instruction in the college in anticipation of affiliation.

Violation of any of the above conditions will lead to the cancellation of affiliation.
