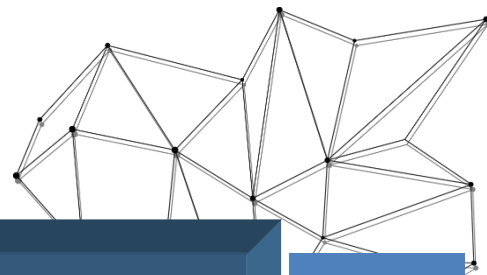

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION



MSc.Electronics

B.Sc Degree in Electronics / Physics / Computer Science / Instrumentation of this University or an equivalent* degree, having studied Electronics as one of the subject and Mathematics as compulsory complementary course, having at least 50% marks or equivalent CGPA in Part III (Core and Complementary put together).OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST/ PwD candidates need only to get a pass.

MSc.Computer Science

The candidate should have secured at least 55% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA in B Sc.(Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Physics or Mathematics or Statistics or Chemistry) or BCA/ B. Voc in Software Technology/B. Voc in Software Development /B. Voc Data Science, B. Voc Mathematics and AI/B. Voc IT, of this University or an equivalent* degree, OR at least 55% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA in B. Tech/BE (Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Electronics and Telecommunication or Electronics and Communication) recognized # by this University. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST /PwD candidates need only to get a pass.

MCom

Any candidate who has passed B.Com or BBA(earlier BBS) degree of University of Calicut or recognized B.Com, BBA,BBM or BBS degree of any other University or Institutes in any states, with minimum of 45% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA is eligible for admission to the M.Com programme . OBC/OEC candidates are eligible for relaxation up to 5%.SC/ST/PwD candidates need to get a pass". In case of B. Com Honours and B.Com (Professional) and BBA (Honours) ,the minimum eligibility for admission is a minimum of 50% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA , for all categories of students.

MA English

BA English Language & Literature/BA English & History/BA Functional English/ BA English with Islamic History or BA/B Sc (excluding alternative pattern) Degree with English as Common Course (Part I), of this University or an equivalent* degree, with at least 45% aggregate marks or equivalent overall CGPA. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST/PwD candidates need only to get a pass.

For Non-BA (English) category candidates applying for M A English Language & Literature, admission will be based on an Entrance Test. A candidate should score at least 50% marks in the Entrance Test for admission in this category. Admission of such candidates will be to the one seat reserved (for each MA English Language & Literature programme) in the affiliated colleges of the University and this seat will be set apart from the General Quota

In the case of candidates with eligible triple main/majors, C1=55, C2=12 and C3=12. (First main/major must be physics, 2nd main/major must be mathematics [To be treated as CG2], 3rd main/major is the one which is offered to them [To be treated as CG3]).

For B.ScPhysicsHonoursDegreeholdersapplyingforM.ScPhysics,C1=55,C2=C3=0.

Note

Applicants are directed to refer to the Prospectus/Admission rules (2025-26) published on the University of Calicut website for further clarifications in eligibility if any. Further conditions on eligibility if any, as prescribed by the University of Calicut Prospectus/ Admission rules (2025-26) will be followed. Any changes incorporated by the University of Calicut in the eligibility/admission rules even after the issue of this Prospectus will be valid and binding till the admission process is completed.

Applicants under Sports/Person with disabilities/Andaman& Nicobar Islands/Lakshadweep/Kashmiri students quota are directed to apply directly to the College. For Sports Quota, the admission will be based on the rank list pre-pared by the respective District Sports Council.

RESERVATION

For reservation of seats under various categories, the norms fixed by the University of Calicut will be followed.

ADMISSION

Strictly as per the norms & guidelines issued by the University of Calicut from time to time. Rank list prepared as per the University of Calicut norms/guidelines/Prospectus would be published at the respective institution and their websites. Memo for interview would be sent only by e-mail to the eligible candidates. It is mandatory for the applicants to interact with the respective institutions and visit their websites (if any) to know their rank positions.

There are no management quota seats in Colleges of Applied Science managed by IHRD.

Bonus / Weightage Marks

Bonus/ weight age marks will be added to the index marks for ranking purpose.

1. 5% of the selection index will be added as grace marks/points to the index marks for those candidates who passed their qualifying examinations from University of Calicut.
2. Students who have worked in the Illiteracy Eradication Programme on voluntary basis in any capacity **for at least one year** will be allowed 5 bonus marks/points for PG admission.(Circular- GA I/A2/4990/1988 dated 06.06.1994).
3. 5 (Five) marks / points for PG admissions shall be awarded as bonus marks to N.S.S / N.C.C cadets subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions, for the purpose of ranking.

a. In respect of NCC applicants the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of NCC certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC to the candidates who have secured at least 75% of attendance after having participated in its activities during the course of the study which is included in the eligibility criteria for the programme /course for which admission is sought (U.O.No 9923/2022/Admn Dated:12.05.2022).

b. For awarding bonus marks/points to NSS participants the basis will be N.S.S. certificates signed by the Vice-Chancellor and issued by the University to volunteers who have completed 240 hours of work with in a period of two years in the programme of study immediately preceding the programmes/courses for which admission is sought.

c. The benefit of bonus marks for the purpose of admission can be availed by the candidates only under any one category, either N.S.S or N.C.C.

d. Cadets holding NCCA, B,C certificates are eligible for an additional weightage of 3,5,10 marks respectively for admission to Post Graduate programmes, limited to a maximum of 10 points only.

e. The bonus points or additional weightage marks will be given to those cases of NCC Certificates even if grace marks have already been awarded. (U.O No.685/2017/Admn Dated:17.01.2017).

4. 10 marks shall be deducted out of the ranking points, for every successive attempt after first attempt for those who have taken two or more chances to complete the qualifying examination, subject to a maximum of 25 marks. The number of chances means the number of chances taken for passing any part or parts of the qualifying examination **after the normal period** fixed for the completion of the qualifying programme/course. Betterment/Improvement examination will not be considered as a chance.



3.HOW TO APPLY

Online Application

Applications for admission to various Post Graduate Degree courses in the Colleges of Applied Sciences in IHRD /College quota seats is to be submitted online through the website of IHRD www.ihrdadmissions.org strictly following the time schedule prescribed by the University of Calicut. The print out of the online application completed along with the details of the remittance of required Application Registration Fee and the other documents are to be submitted to the Principal of the college concerned at the time of admission or on demand from the college where he/she desires to secure admission. Separate online application should be Submitted for seeking admission to different Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD.(Please see Para 1, for the communication address of the Colleges of Applied Science).

***Before applying online for admission to seats filled by Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD directly, the candidate should have completed the online registration at the University of Calicut CAP admission portal.**

Single Window Application

Registration fee

The application Registration fee will be Rs.250/- (Rs.100/- for SC/ST candidates). Additional remittance of Rs.100/- per college (SC/ST Rs.50/-) is needed to apply to more college. **Students will be able to give options to all the colleges of IHRD under Calicut University through single registration and payment.** Application Registration Fee should be paid to the bank account of respective College of Applied Science given in Para1 through online bank transfer in favor of the Principal of the College of Applied Science concerned where the applicant desires to get admission. Application Registration fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

Submission of Application

The print out taken after final submission of online application along with supporting documents shall be kept by the candidate him/herself and produced before the Principal of College of Applied Science concerned at the time of admission or on demand from the college. Late/incomplete applications/Applications not in the prescribed form/Applications without Application Registration Fee will be summarily rejected.

A candidate can submit application for admission to Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD directly also if online submission of application is not possible. The candidate may download the application form from the IHRD website www.ihrdadmissions.org and filled up application form along with proof of remittance of Application Registration Fee may be sent by post to reach the office of the Principal, College of Applied Science where the candidate wishes to get admitted before the last date of submission of online applications fixed by the University of Calicut. In such case Application Registration fee may be paid through DD taken in favor of the Principal of the respective College of Applied Science.

**Last date of submission of online application is subject to change according to change in the admissions schedule as notified by the University or/and as decided by the principal of the respective institution at which the candidate applies for admission.*

Fee remittance schedule

First Semester fee should be paid at the time of admission and Semester fee for all the remaining Semesters should be paid at the beginning of each semester. However Principals of colleges are allowed to change the above schedule of fee payment suitably in deserving cases.

Note

- In addition, the student will have to remit the University affiliation/administration and other mandatory fees as required by the University of Calicut from time to time, including University Examination Fee.
- The PTA Fee, Magazine Fee, Association Fee, etc as recommended by the college concerned should also be remitted at the time of admission
- The Semester fee and other university charges payable by the candidates for each semester are to be paid in time**

As per the circular issued by the Director /HOI, IHRD. Defaulters as on stipulated date shown in the circular will be removed from the rolls and shall be readmitted on remittance of entire fee along with Rs.60/- for 10 days and defaulters after 10 days will have to pay an admission fee of Rs.1100/- along with entire fee and Rs.60/- fine for further 10 days more.

Under any circumstances, defaulters after readmission fee will not be readmitted to obey the orders issued by the University and IHRD from time to time in this regard.

SC/ST students who receive fee concession are reminded to remit the tuition fees to the respective college, immediately on receipt of the same in their bank accounts without delay. They are also informed that the tuition fee received in their account is not for personal spending under any circumstances and any misuse of Govt. funds may lead to legal action by the concerned authorities.

Fee concession

1. All students are required to pay Caution Deposit irrelevant of category including SC/ST/OEC candidates
2. SC/ST/OEC candidates and any other category as directed by the Govt. / University will be exempted from payment of the prescribed fee on the condition that they will submit the application for educational concession to the SC/ST Development Department in the prescribed form along with supporting documents within 15 days from the date of admission. If they fail to do so, or if educational concession is not sanctioned by the SC/ST Development Department, the student is liable to remit the entire fee.
3. All students including those eligible for any type of Educational Concession from various Departments/Welfare Agencies other than the SC/ST/OEC or any other category as prescribed by the Govt. from time to time should remit the entire fee as per schedule. But the due amount sanctioned towards the educational concession to the eligible students by the Department/ Welfare agencies will be reimbursed to them by the Principal, as and when it is received in the institution.

5.DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION

The candidate shall produce the following documents at the time of interview for admission.

1. Originals of SSLC, Degree/Provisional Certificate and all Mark lists of the Qualifying Examination, T.C, Conduct Certificate, Equivalency/Migration Certificate whichever is applicable.
2. Originals of Community and Other certificates to claim reservation/bonus/weight age if applicable.

6. RULES FOR ISSUE OF TRANSFER CERTIFICATE



1. Any student who gets admission to PG Programmes later discontinues his/her study from any one of the College of Applied Science, managed by IHRD, TC will be issued as per conditions specified in the G.O.(MS)no. 319/2017/H.Edn.(J)dated29-12-2017. i.e. In the event of a student with drawing before the starting of the course, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One thousand only)will be refunded by the College. If a student leaves after joining the course (after the date of commencement of classes) and if the vacated seat is consequently filled by another student by the last date of admission, the college will refund the fee collected after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs. 1,000/-(Rupees One thousand only) and proportionate educations of monthly fee. In case the vacated seat is not filled, the candidate is eligible to get refund of the Caution Deposit only. All such refund will be processed only after closure of PG admission by the University of Calicut.
2. Fee for the candidates getting admission in any of the Colleges of Applied Science, managed by IHRD, prior to the closure of admission during the same admission year will be adjusted after deducting the Admission fee. If a student applies for TC to join Higher Option allotted by Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) for the PG admission of the University of Calicut, the TC and other documents will be issued as per the University guidelines in time to time.
3. In case of Inter College transfer between Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD with in the same University and Programme after the date of closure of admission, TC will be issued on payment of Rs. 2000/- towards processing fee. In such cases, the applicant is eligible to get refund of 75% of the tuition fee only through inter institutional transfer.



7. GENERAL CONDITIONS

2. Selection of candidates will be made by the Principals concerned, based on the information furnished in the online application by the candidate.
3. The selection for admission will be provisional and subject to verification of any information given in the application. If any information is found to be false or suppressed, the candidate will forfeit his/her claim for admission.
4. The candidates called for interview should bring the originals of all the certificates on the date specified. TC should be produced within a week from the date of provisional admission.
5. A candidate who does not turn up for the interview as per the schedule and at the place and time will forfeit his/her chance for admission and will not be considered for any future vacancies for admission irrespective of the rank secured. However, if a candidate is not able to attend the interview on genuine grounds, the parent/guardian or any authorized person can act as a proxy at the risk of the candidate. The candidate seeking admission to the course will have to abide by the campus rules and regulations issued from time to time.
6. . Consumption of Alcohol, Drugs and Smoking is strictly prohibited within the campus. Students are advised to desist, from the habit of smoking drugs and drinking all together, as it is well known that smoking, drugs and drinking is injurious to health. Students found in intoxicated state in the campus will be suspended immediately and will face strict disciplinary action including dismissal if found guilty.
7. Students are requested to co-operate to maintain the building and the campus clean and spotless, as well as to keep the furniture, laboratory equipment and other institute properties without loss or damage. This is a collective responsibility of the students.
8. Late entry to class rooms or labs/workshops will not be allowed.
9. The identity card issued by the Institute must be prominently displayed on the chest by each student. Repossession of the card is not enough.
10. Directions of the Principal and other staff in respect of academic matters and general discipline must be strictly complied with, by all students.
11. Leave of absence will be granted only on medical grounds. However such leave will be considered only for the purpose of granting condonation of shortage of attendance.
12. Hostel facilities are not provided by the Colleges of Applied Science under IHRD and hence the students will have to make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging.
13. Use of mobile phones, performance of cinematic dance and fashion shows is strictly banned in the campus and Punishable by fine and other disciplinary action as per the rules of the institution.



8. PREVENTION OF RAGGING IN CAMPUS



RAGGING IS A COGNISABLE OFFENCE AND PUNISHABLE UNDER PROVISIONS OF KERALA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT. 1998.

The institution will take stern action against the offenders. The cardinal points contained in the act are furnished below for information of the concerned

SHORT TITLE AND EXTENT

- a) The Act may be called the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1998
- b) It extends to the whole of the State of Kerala

“**Ragging**” means display of disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution and includes :

- a. Teasing, abusing of, playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such student;
- b. Asking the student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary situation willingly do.

PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

Ragging within or without any educational institution is prohibited

PENALTY OF RAGGING

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within, or without, any educational institution, shall on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

DISMISSAL OF STUDENT

Any student convicted of an offence under section (4) shall also be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of three years from the date of order of such dismissal.

SUSPENSION OF STUDENT

1. Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and, if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately, forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated for further action.
2. Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is proved that there is no substance prima facie in the complaint received under sub-section (1), he shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant.

Copy of the prohibition of Ragging Act 1998 will be available in the institution for reference. The applicants as well as his/her parent/guardian are required to furnish declaration on the awareness of the provisions of the Act in the application form.

Any other details not specifically covered by this prospectus will be decided by the undersigned and such decision will be final.
